Option #1: Status Quo

-Discussion of school capacity

Question: If enrollment is higher than capacity, does that mean portables?

Glenn: Yes.

Question: The numbers at GAN have decreased. Have GAN students shifted to MLE?

Jennifer: The boundaries overlap, it is a unique relationship.

Option #2: Replacement/Rebuild

Some considerations:

- Option of possible replacement of MLE, replacement of SBE

Option #3: Retrofit

Some considerations:

- Option of retrofit SBE, MLE, GAN

Option #4: Consolidate, Close and Replace

Some considerations:

- Partial replacement of MLE and move GAN students to MLE
- Rebuilt SBE and move GAN, to SBE
- Move SBE, GAN, MLE to one site

Option #5: Boundary Optimization

Possible for all schools

Questions & Answers:

1. If we close GAN, would those parents go to the new public school?
Rich: Unlikely, GAN and MLE are the same families.
2. Do we have a breakdown by division to know how to accommodate children?
Glenn: Yes, we have that information.
3. Do we have a site, if we consolidate?
Glenn/Darren: Would have to be investigated as well as funding for other alternatives.
4. Could we adjust program to accommodate? Offer a school only to grade 3?
: Yes, a consideration.
5. What about identity if we combine communities? Can we learn from the public system?
6. Site?
Is five acre site a possibility in West Ridge? How would a school there affect boundaries because of its location on the other side of the highway?
7. Could we build another school, if NOD continues to grow?
Glenn: We have a boundary change as an option.
Darren: A new school sounds good but who ends up there? What boundary changes are necessary? It is not always the best option.
8. What is the projection for Fogarty?
Jennifer: Difficult to measure – open access.
Will the Fogarty site accommodate their future growth over the coming years?
Glenn: Yes.
