

<p>ADE <i>Average Daily Enrolment</i></p>	<p>The calculation of the number of students enrolled in a school based on two count dates, October 31st and March 31st, with equal weight given to each count date and with Junior and Senior Kindergarten students being recognized as half-time students.</p>
<p>FTE <i>Full Time Equivalent</i></p>	<p>The enrolment calculated based on the number of students attending a school; however, the JK and SK students are counted as 0.5 they are in school half time.</p>
<p>HEAD COUNT/BODIES</p>	<p>The enrolment based on the total number of students.</p>
<p>FOL</p>	<p>Foley Catholic School <i>abbreviation</i>.</p>
<p>GAN</p>	<p>Guardian Angels School <i>abbreviation</i>.</p>
<p>MLE</p>	<p>Monsignor Lee Elementary School <i>abbreviation</i></p>
<p>NOD</p>	<p>Notre Dame Catholic School <i>abbreviation</i>.</p>
<p>SBE</p>	<p>St. Bernard’s School <i>abbreviation</i>.</p>
<p>B.S.I.D.</p>	<p>Ministry of Education’s school identification number.</p>
<p>D.S.B</p>	<p>District School Board.</p>
<p>EQAO <i>Education Quality and Accountability Office</i></p>	<p>An arm’s-length agency of the provincial government, that designs and implements a comprehensive program of student assessment within government- established parameters. EQAO develops and implements a provincial education quality indicators program, leads Ontario’s participation in national and international assessments, and promotes research in best practices in assessment and accountability. EQAO reports to the Minister of Education, the public and the education community on assessment and education issues and makes recommendations for improvement.</p>
<p>FCI <i>Facility Condition Index</i></p>	<p>A ratio used to measure the relative condition of a building taking into account all building systems. It is calculated by dividing the Cost of Repairs for the building by the Current Replacement Value of the building.</p>
	<p>FACILITY CONDITION INDEX = $\frac{\text{Cost of Repairs}}{\text{Current Replacement Value}}$</p>
<p>FD45</p>	<p>FD45 refers to Full Day 4 & 5 year olds (JK/SK). This is a program the Ministry of Education is considering implementing for 2010 & beyond.</p>

It refers to a full day, every day program for JK/SK students.

The measure of the size of the building in square metres.

GFA

Gross Floor Area

NPP

New Pupil Placement

The Ministry approved New Pupil Place capacity used to determine Boards eligibility for grants for New Pupil Places. This capacity was determined in 1998 and is frozen. Portables are not included.

OPERATING COSTS

All the expenditures required to operate and maintain the Board and its facilities including but not limited to heating, lighting, cleaning, routine maintenance and administrative costs.

OTG

School Capacity or On The Ground Capacity

The current rated capacity for a facility as indicated on the Ministry of Education's School Facilities Inventory System. This may differ from NPP.

PAC

Pupil Accommodation Committee

A committee established of parents, guardians, staff and school council members within a particular review area that will study, evaluate, report and make recommendations to the Board on School accommodation options.

PAR

Pupil Accommodation Review

A Pupil Accommodation Review is a formal process, following the Ministry of Education guidelines, which helps us evaluate and review how we accommodate students in our schools. This process assists us with planning so that we can best meet the needs of our students and parents now and in the future.

REPLACEMENT

Term used to describe the concept of demolishing a school building and rebuilding in its entirety on the same site.

RETROFIT

Term used to describe the concept of renovating a school building.

SFD

Single Family Dwelling

Type of residential housing typically designed for one family unit.

SFIS

School Facility Inventory System

Ministry of Education on-line database of Board capital assets.

SVF

School Valuation Framework

A tool to be used within the Pupil Accommodation Review whereby each school within the review is valued based on :

- Value to the Student
- Value to the School Board
- Value to the Community
- Value to the Local Economy

UTILIZATION/PERCENT CAPACITY

Percentage amount of students occupying a given school facility, calculated by dividing the school's Average Daily
